Grantor

Terms and Conditions of entry

By completing the attached application the Jubilee Community Grants Program, the entrant accepts these Terms and Conditions of entry.

Who can enter?

Applications are open to all community groups, clubs and individuals located within the proximity of the City of Wyndham. Employees of Jubilee are not eligible to apply.

How to enter?

Entrants must submit a completed Jubilee Community Grants Application Form to the Jubilee Sales & Information Centre located at 39 Memory Crescent, Wyndham Vale between 11am to 5pm by the entry close date. Jubilee accepts no liability for any lost applications forms. Illegible and/or incomplete forms will not be accepted.

Dates of Grants Program

Entries open Tuesday 1 August, 2017 at 12pm and close Tuesday 22 August, 2017 at 5pm.
Any entries received after the close date will not be considered.

Grant Recipients receive

Five community groups will be selected to each receive a one-off \$1,000 grant.
Payment of the \$1,000 grant will be made by cheque.

Judging the applications

The five community grant recipients will be judged by a board of Jubilee representatives, based on the judge's opinions as to the most appropriate response on the entry forms.

Contacting final recipients

The five community grant recipients will be notified by 5pm on Monday 28 August 2017 via the telephone number provided in the application and invited to contact Jubilee's PR agency, Papermill Media to arrange the date of presentation of the grant. In the event that a successful grant recipient cannot be contacted via telephone, notification will be made by writing to the address provided on the application form. The successful recipients have until Thursday 7 September 2017 to contact Jubilee to claim the grant. Failure to claim the grant by Thursday 7 September 2017 means the terms of the grant will lapse and new recipients will be selected.

Use of grant

The grant is non-transferable. The grant is to be paid to the successful recipient community group for the purpose of funding extra supplies, materials and/or equipment for the chosen community group and is not for individual or personal use.

Community group contact details

The community group acknowledges that it provides certain information on the application form to be used by Jubilee for future promotional purposes. Individual's personal information cannot be disclosed without the individual's consent.

Acknowledging support and promoting success

Successful grant recipients need to acknowledge Jubilee's support of the community group by giving a grant through the Jubilee Community Grants Program. Successful grant recipients will be required to make available at least one community group representative to participate in Jubilee's media publicity of the Jubilee Community Grants Program. The grant recipient is responsible for obtaining the consent of all community group representatives to participate in media and publicity at which their photograph may be taken and published by Jubilee. The successful grant recipient acknowledges and agrees that Jubilee may publish the details of the successful community group grant recipient in Jubilee's marketing material or reports, including social media, Jubilee's website, brochures or newspapers. Jubilee will also provide promotional material to be distributed by the grant recipient. Successful grant recipients may be required to contribute information on activity outcomes as a result of receiving the community grant.
